

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

Some inventions can even change lives. Ever heard of 'Braille'? Fifteen-year-old Louis Braille invented this clever writing system in 1824. It's based on raised dots and helps visually impaired people (like Louis!) read and write. More recently, a girl called Gitanjali Rao developed a low-cost device to detect contaminated

> drinking water. She first started working on the idea when she was eleven years old. Yep, eleven!
